ROTATE OR FACE *THE RESISTANCE*



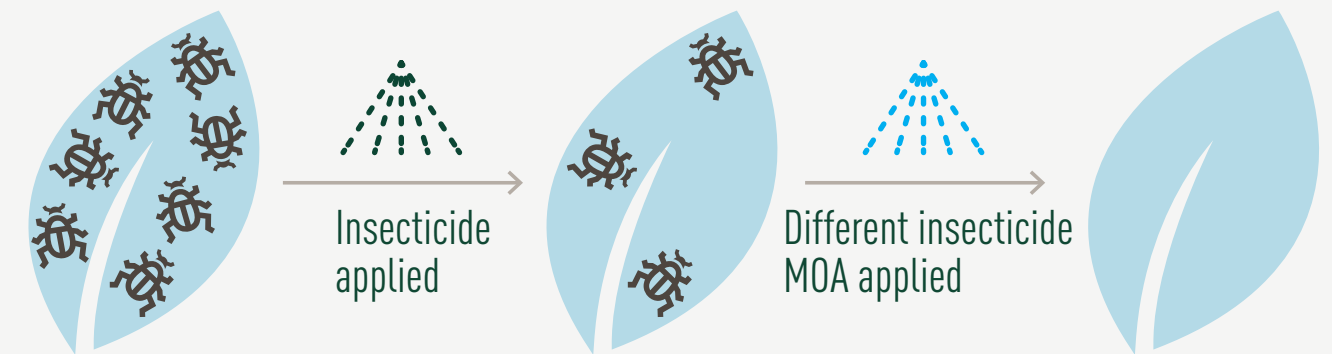
Rotating your insecticide mode of action reduces the risk of developing future insect resistance. Here's why:

USING THE SAME MODE OF ACTION



After applying an insecticide, insects that are resistant to its mode of action may survive. Using the same mode of action again increases their population and the risk of future resistance problems.

ROTATING THE MODE OF ACTION



Rotating to a different mode of action increases your chances of eliminating resistant insects. Reducing their population helps preserve your existing modes of action while reducing the risk of resistance.

Keep your insecticides effective. Rotate your modes of action.
